This week is Social Justice Week. Our theme is 'Enabling Communities.' All of us encounter limitations in our lives, whether they be intellectual, physical, mental, or social.

When these limitations prevent us from participating in important human activities, then we can say we are dealing with a disability. In a real sense, the disability comes about as a result of the interaction between our impairment and environmental barriers. Each of us experience disabilities

in quite different ways. For some of us, it may be very personal, as we learn to participate as fully as possible in our society, with particular impairments. Others meet disability through their relationship to others. In our schools, this reality is no different, where both teachers and students live with disabilities in different ways. In fact, a school setting is often the easiest place to see that we all possess different strengths and weaknesses, vastly different abilities and disabilities.

As we consider what we can and can't do, we must remember that we are all created by God and have an inherent and immeasurable worth and dignity. God calls us to love and respect his creation – including all those around us. This Social Justice Week we put the spotlight on disability and pose the challenge for us all to promote communities that enable everyone to be included, and to have the chance to play their part.
