Summer Uniform...Term 4 2018 and Term 1 2019...

Term 4 sees the whole school change in to regulation summer uniform. Please Note: That ALL children are to wear the school regulation royal blue wide brimmed hat as part of our sun safe policy. Staff will fully enforce our sun safe policy where students without a regulation sun hat will be required to stay under shade for intervals and lunch times. Any other hats worn will not be acceptable.

As we enter the second to last week of the term, our focus is on our school production 'Rewind.'

The students and staff have been working extremely hard behind the scenes to get ready for this showcase. Tomorrow we are having our first run through of the performance. We need all costumes to be at school if not here already.

Ticket orders have been sent home when processed and there are now limited tickets available as we head towards sold out shows.

Later in the week you will receive a notice which will have the information needed for Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday next week. Please read carefully. The notice will also be available on our school app under daily notices.

Supervision and safety of students before and after school

Just a reminder that students are allowed on school grounds from 8:15 am onwards. The only exception for students to be here before this time is for children that are booked into the SKIDS Before School Programme. We are having more and more students arrive prior to 8:15 am which is not okay. Our staff are on site from 8:15 am onwards so please help us by adhering to this.

We are noticing that there are a large number of students staying after school. The bell goes at 2:55 pm and we expect all students (except bus and SKIDS) to be off site by 3:15 pm (unless they are with their parents.) We do not provide after school supervision for the playground, it is for bus supervision only. If you are picking up your child, please do so as early as possible.

Church Entrance

A number of students are using the side gate (church entrance) and waiting for parents in the church car park. This is NOT a wait zone. The side gate is only to be used by students when they are accompanied by parents. We have informed the children that if parents are waiting in the church car park then they must exit via the Victoria Street entrance. This is for health and safety reasons. The church grounds are not school grounds and this area is not supervised. Thank you for your support with this.

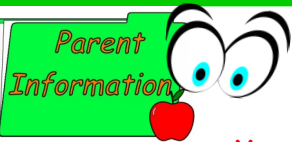

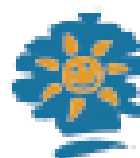

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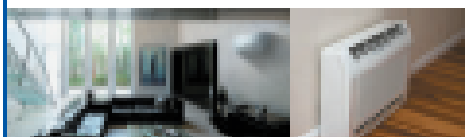
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
