Supervision and Safety of Students Before and After School

Just a reminder that students are allowed on school grounds from 8:15 am onwards. The only exception for students to be here before this time is for children that are booked into the SKIDS Before School Programme. We are having more and more students arrive prior to 8:15 am which is not okay. Our staff are on site from 8:15 am onwards so please help us by adhering to this.

We are noticing that there are a large number of students staying after school. The bell goes at 2:55 pm and we expect all students (except bus and SKIDS) to be off site by 3:15 pm (unless they are with their parents.) We do not provide after school supervision for the playground, it is for bus supervision only. If you are picking up your child, please do so as early as possible.

The side gate is only to be used by students when they are accompanied by parents. 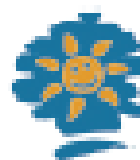

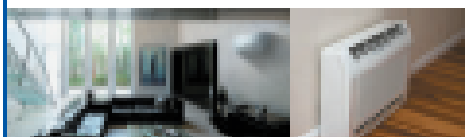
